


## Dane House

Specialist Learning Disability & Autism  
Community Based Living



### Overview

Dane House is a six bed mixed gender community based home, with a range of communal facilities including lounges, dining room and kitchen alongside a large garden. The people who are supported at Dane House may be living with severe learning disabilities, autism and behaviours which, due to their diagnosis may be seen as challenging. Residents may also have profound and multiple communication difficulties, sensory impairments and physical health problems.

People may come to Dane House as part of their care pathway. They may already be living in the community, such as the family home or supported living, but require more structured care and support. They may also be moving out of a residential school.

The service is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by a dedicated team made up of the Registered Manager, Team Leaders and Support Workers. All residents are registered with the local GP and access primary care services in the community.

Elysium Care Partnerships are proud of the excellent relationships with the families and friends of the people they support. Families and friends are encouraged to play an active part in the lives of their loved ones.

Dane House is located in Brighton within walking distance of an array of local facilities and resources. Brighton has excellent transport links across the south of England and direct train routes in to London.

Sitting at the heart of local communities our small homes are designed specifically for young people transitioning into adulthood who may be leaving residential schools or the family home who require support in a residential setting. Our homes also provide a structured setting that may suit those who are stepping down from hospital or avoiding an inappropriate hospital admission. Our aim is that residents will progress onto a more independent living setting within the community but others may stay with us longer term for further support.

We are committed to continually improving our service delivery and providing services which meet changing demand, often developing bespoke services around specific individuals identified through the Transforming Care Programme.
