

Pinhoe View Acute Service

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Overview

Pinhoe View is a 16 bed purpose built, female acute inpatient service specialising in the assessment, treatment and stabilisation of individuals in crisis or suffering from a significant mental health illness.

The aim of the service is to provide a stabilising environment working with individuals in periods of crisis and acute phases of their mental illness in the least restrictive way.





Our service is supported by a full Multidisciplinary team consisting of Consultant Psychiatrist, Registered Nurses, Healthcare Workers, Clinical Psychologist, Assistant Psychologist and Occupational Therapy team offering a recovery focused approach.

The team work in collaboration with patients to develop person-centred care plans on admission, with an ultimate aim of stabilisation and providing a pathway of care back to the community.

Who we treat

Patient Profile

- Women aged 18+
- Informal or detained under the Mental Health Act 1983 (amended 2007)
- Experiencing difficulties that present a risk to the wellbeing of themselves or others that cannot be treated in an open environment

Diagnoses may include:

- Acute mental illness
- Acute depressive illness
- Psychosis
- Schizophrenia
- Bipolar disorder
- Dual diagnosis
- Personality Disorder
- Patients may also present with substance misuse and self-harm issues



Referrals and Enquiries:

We accept referrals and admit from all areas, including A&E, section 136 suites and other acute services. Referrals are accepted 24hrs a day, 365 days a year, with a turnaround time of 1 hour subject to suitable clinical information being provided.
