



Overview

Pathfields Lodge is a specialist care home providing supportive and therapeutic care for adults with a physical disability, brain injury, neurological condition or learning disability. With a 24-hour on-site nursing team, we are also able to support individuals with additional physical health conditions.

Service Aims

The service aims to support each person to achieve their own personal, maximum level of independence and to live a meaningful and happy life. Individuals are allocated their own personal Key Worker who ensures that wishes and needs are voiced and heard. The whole team is dedicated to providing the very best support for those we support.

Promoting Social Inclusion

Wherever possible, we encourage service users to pursue interests away from the service. Families and friends can visit at any time to join in with life at the service and often join us for a variety of seasonal events. We have wheelchair accessible vehicles and facilitate several outings including pub lunches, days at the seaside and trips to the zoo.

Life at Pathfields Lodge

We actively encourage service users to take part in the varied activity programme available within the service. We employ dedicated Activity Coordinators who spend time determining people's interests and capabilities. Activities aim to increase independence in undertaking everyday tasks such as shopping, gardening, and budgeting. Activities are changed regularly to accommodate each person's changing needs and preferences.

Environment

We offer a homely and welcoming environment conducive to the physical, mental, and social wellbeing of service users. The service has several communal areas for socialising as well as a large garden. Two training kitchens are available for individuals to practice their daily living skills.

There is also an activities room for arts and crafts, music, and films as well as a hairdressing salon with a visiting hairdresser.

Pathways

The spectrum of Elysium Neurological services across the UK covers the following five pathways for inpatient, residential care and respite stays for men and women over the age of 18.



Neurorehabilitation

Assessment, rehabilitation, flexible packages for ABI or neurological conditions



Complex Physical Conditions – as a result of a neurological problem

Including disorders of consciousness, spinal injury, tracheostomy care, ventilation and complex stroke



Neurobehavioural

Specialised behavioural programmes including people who may be detained under the Mental Act 1983 (amended 2007)



Neuroprogressive Conditions

Including Huntington's Disease, Motor Neurone Disease, Multiple Sclerosis and Parkinson's Disease



Complex Dementias

Including Frontotemporal, Pick's, Lewy Body, Korsakoff, young-onset or vascular



Location

Located in the peaceful Northamptonshire countryside, Pathfields Lodge is close to the towns of Rushden (1 mile), Wellingborough (5 miles), Kettering (9 miles) and Northampton (12 miles).

Who is the service for?

- Adults over the age of 18
- May have an acquired or traumatic brain injury or other neurological condition
- May have a long-term physical disability
- May have complex physical health needs such as diabetes or epilepsy
